What do we measure and why?

Island Health's Home Care Professional services provide care for patients after they leave hospital and ongoing support and healthcare to clients to enable them to remain independent and in their homes for as long as possible. There are many types of home care services available.

The Home Care Professional Services measure reflects the percentage of home care clients who are seen by home care nurses, or rehabilitation or case management professionals (after they have been assessed, prioritized and referred to the service), within benchmark response times. The benchmark response times vary based on the urgency of the client's needs.

What is the target?

Island Health's target is to meet benchmark response times for at least 80% of clients.

Higher rates are better.

How are we doing?

As of November 2023, Island Health is not meeting the target.

What actions are we taking?

Performance is reviewed monthly at the Community Care Steering Committee. Development of a Home Care measurement framework focusing on quality metrics for professional services is underway.
